



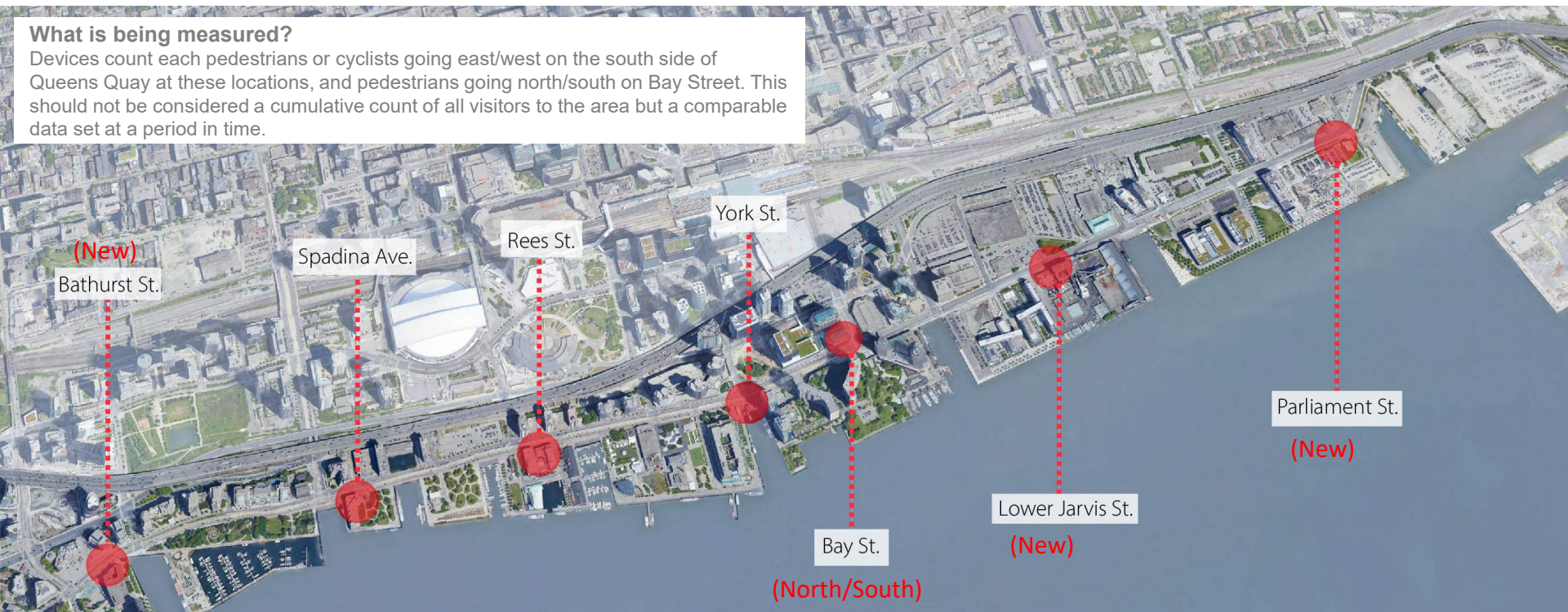
Pedestrian Count Summary

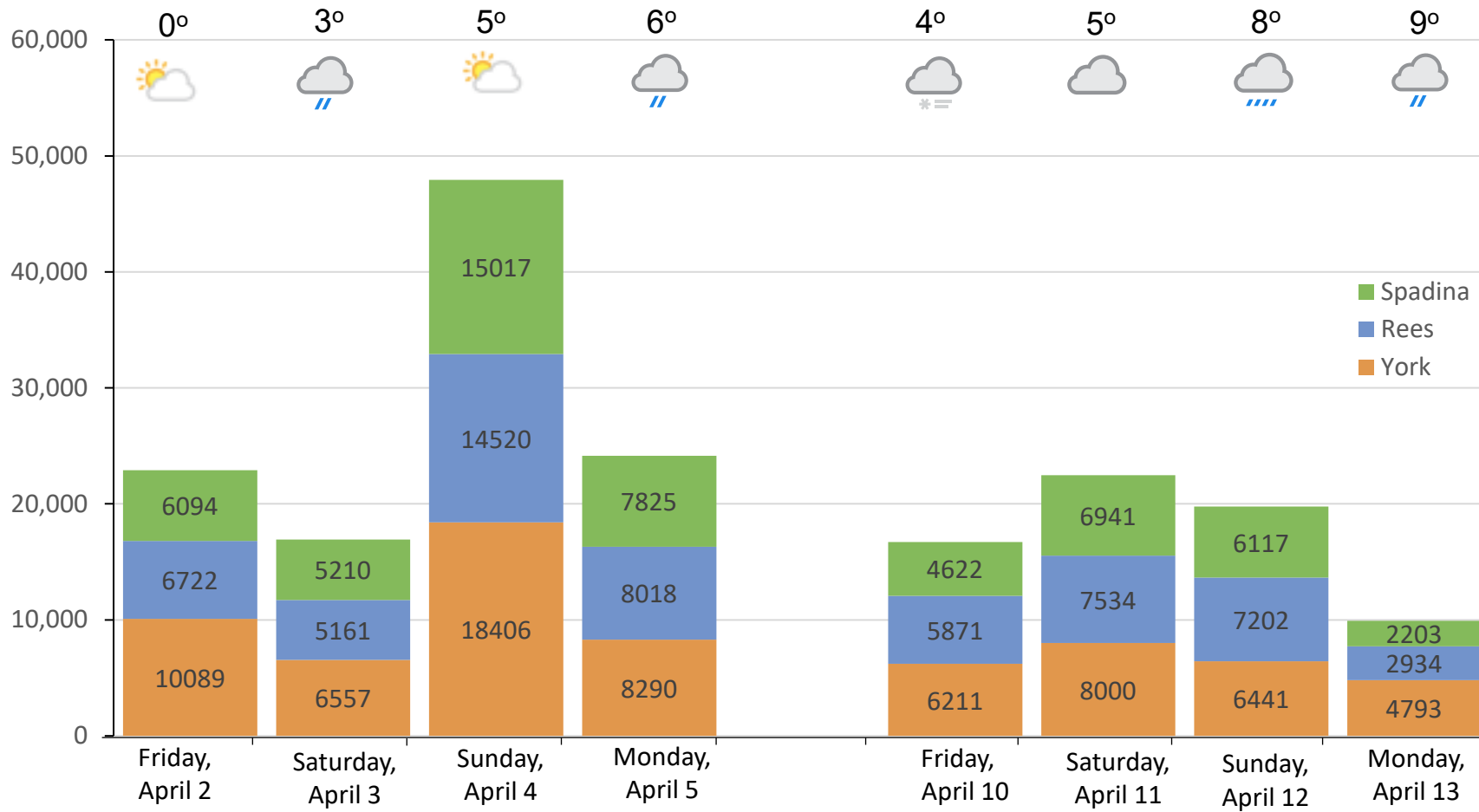
*Easter Long Weekend

What is being measured?

Devices count each pedestrians or cyclists going east/west on the south side of Queens Quay at these locations, and pedestrians going north/south on Bay Street. This should not be considered a cumulative count of all visitors to the area but a comparable data set at a period in time.

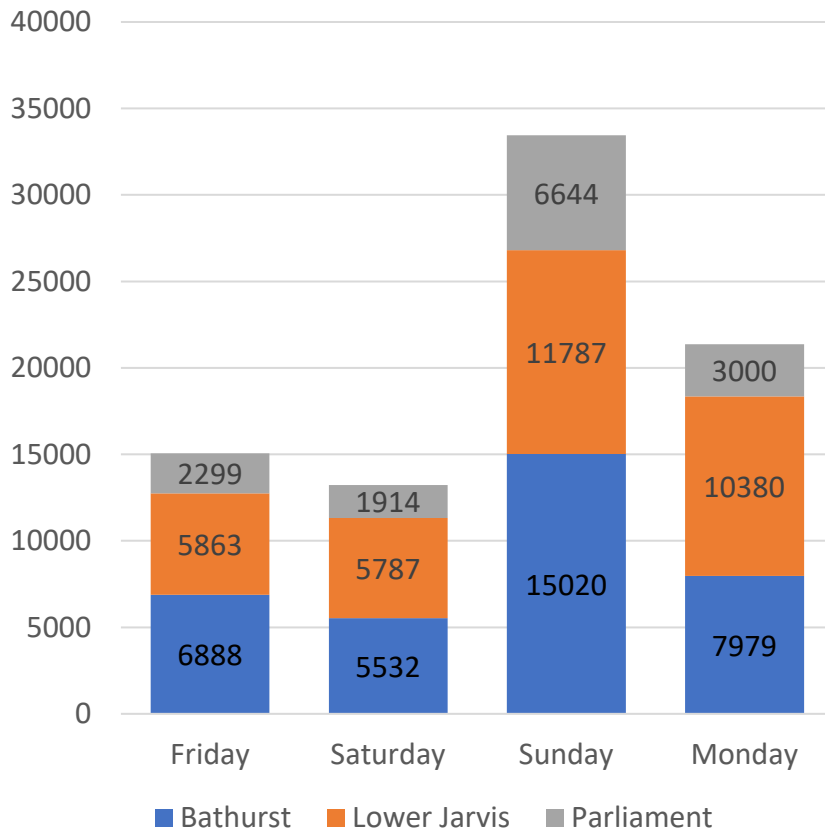

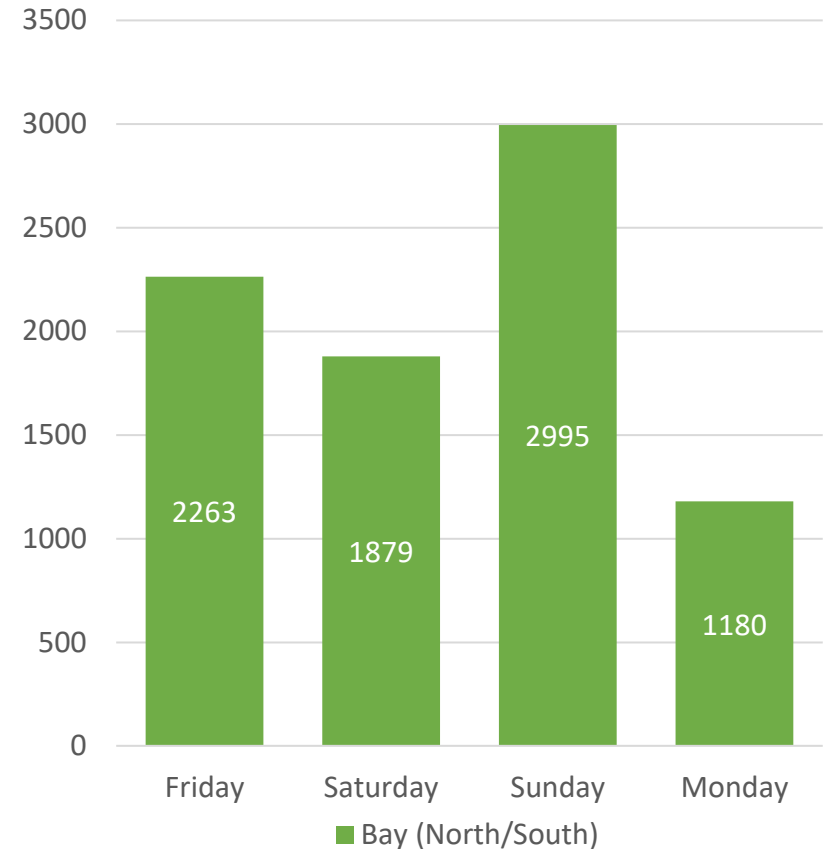
Pedestrian Counts for New Counter Locations

East/West Counters



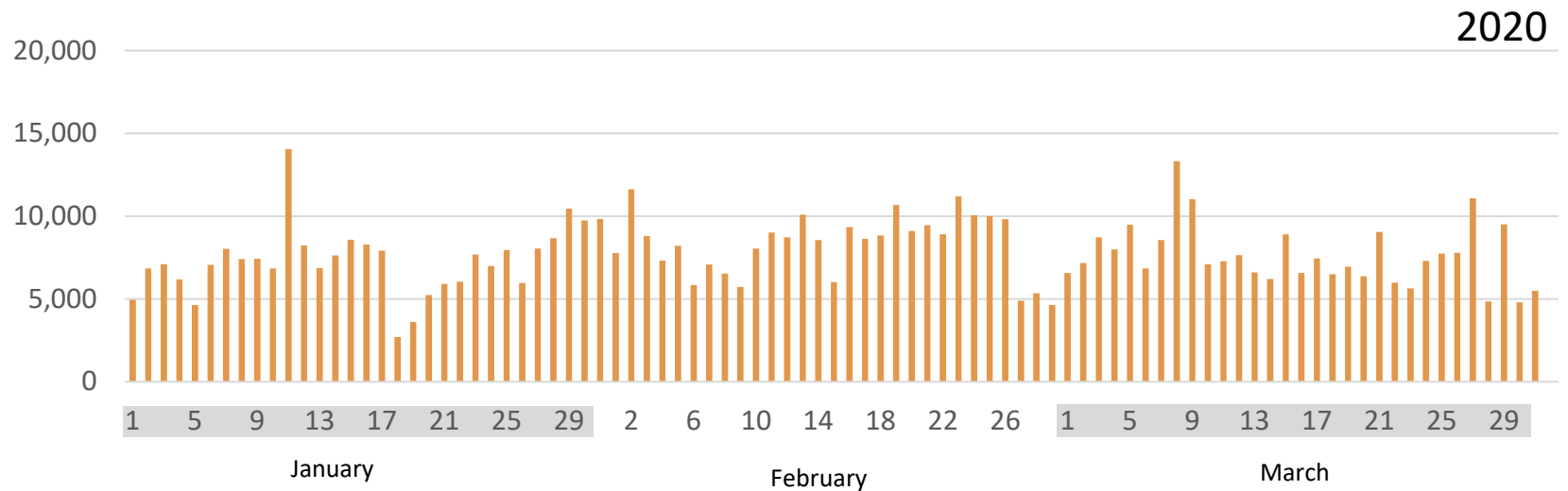
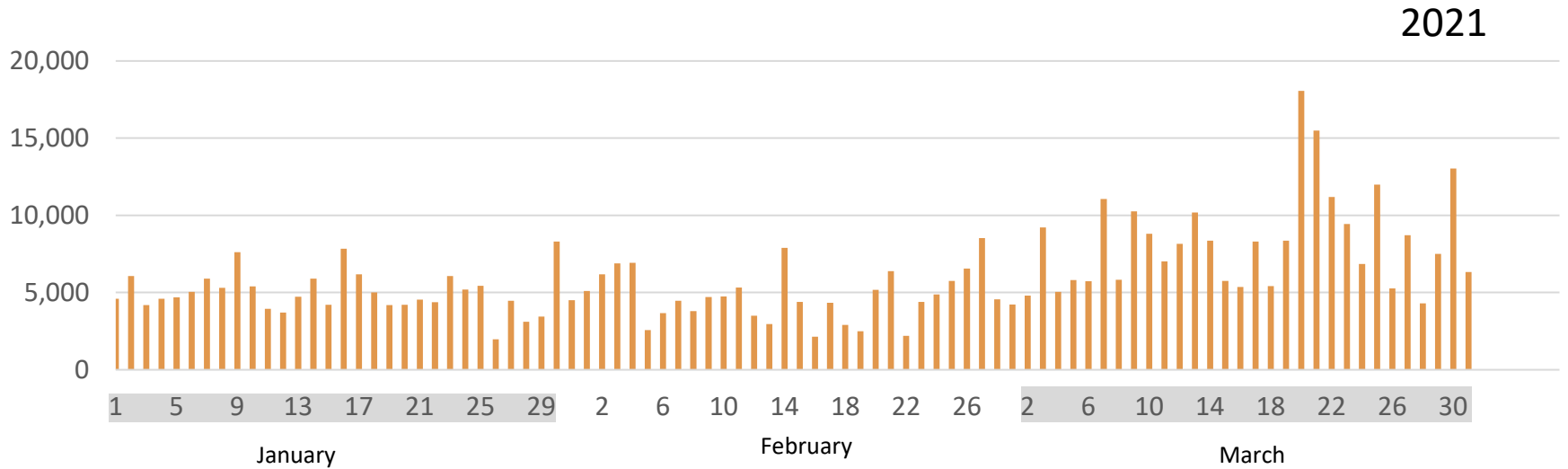
Bay (North/South)

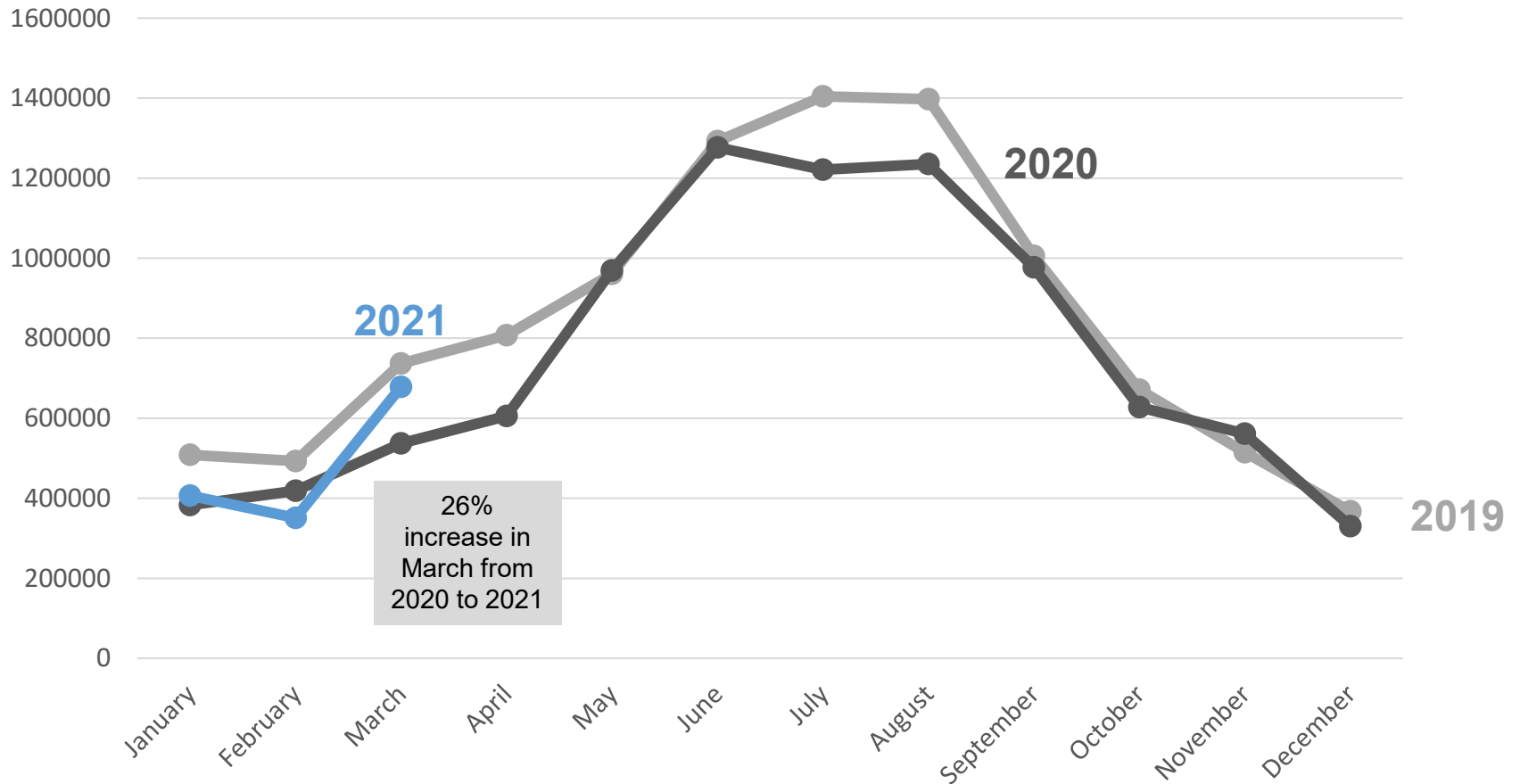
First Quarter of 2021 Compared to 2020 – York St.
