### **Traffic disruptions – Lower Simcoe Street to be closed this weekend at Lake Shore Boulevard**

**June 17, 2022** – To ensure the safety and reliability of our pipeline distribution system, Enbridge Gas is working through a four-stage Lake Shore Boulevard pipeline replacement project, since the current pipeline is nearing the end of its lifespan.

To accommodate construction work on this project, lane closures are tentatively scheduled to happen periodically from May 9, 2022 until November 2022, on Lake Shore Boulevard West, in both directions, from Spadina Avenue to Yonge Street.

This weekend, there will be a **road closure from Saturday, June 18, at 7 a.m. until Sunday, June 19, at 7 p.m.**

During this time, Lower Simcoe Street will be closed to north and southbound traffic at Lake Shore Boulevard. Any affected traffic will be diverted onto Lake Shore Boulevard West.

Please note this closure is subject to change based on weather and other factors.

The project was planned in accordance with Ontario Energy Board (OEB) regulations. To gain approval from the OEB, an environmental and cumulative effects assessment and Environmental Report was completed. Enbridge filed a "Leave to Construct" application with the OEB in May 2020, and the project was approved in 2020.
