

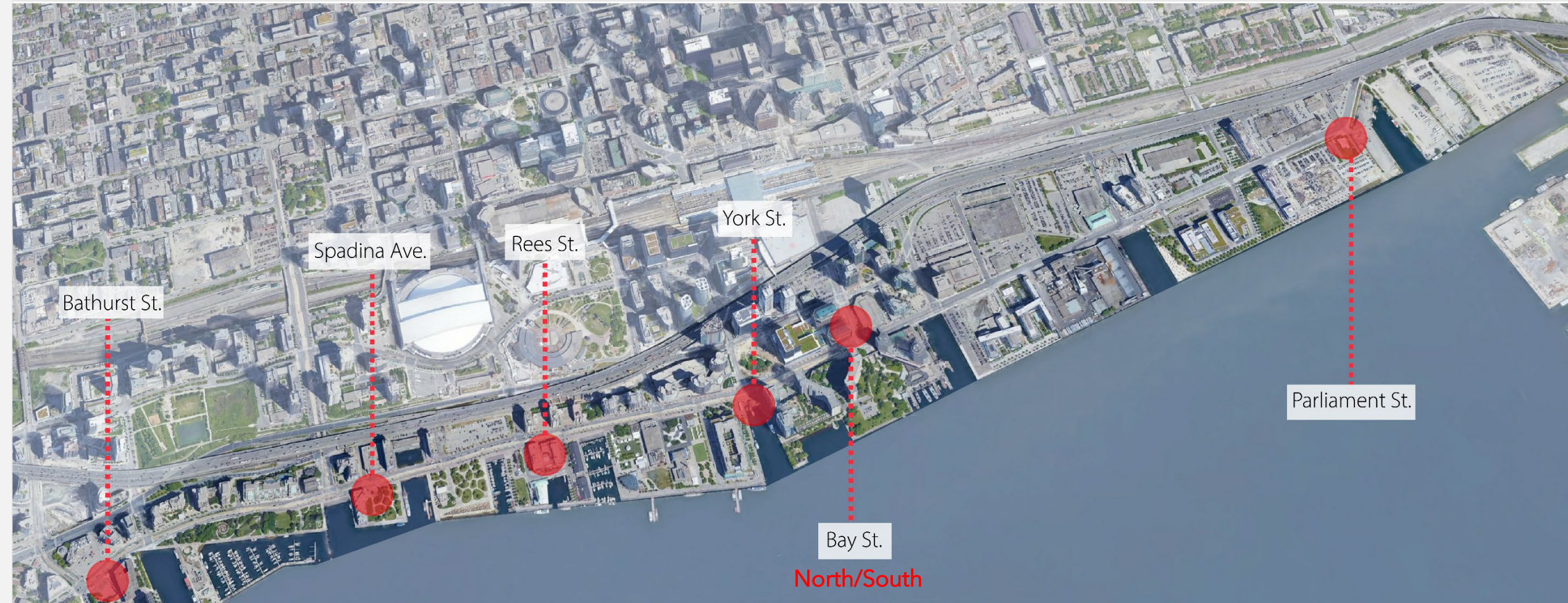

### WHAT IS BEING MEASURED?

Devices count each pedestrian or cyclist going east/west on the south side of Queens Quay at these locations, and pedestrians going north/south on Bay Street. This should not be considered a cumulative count of all visitors to the area but a comparable data set at a period in time.

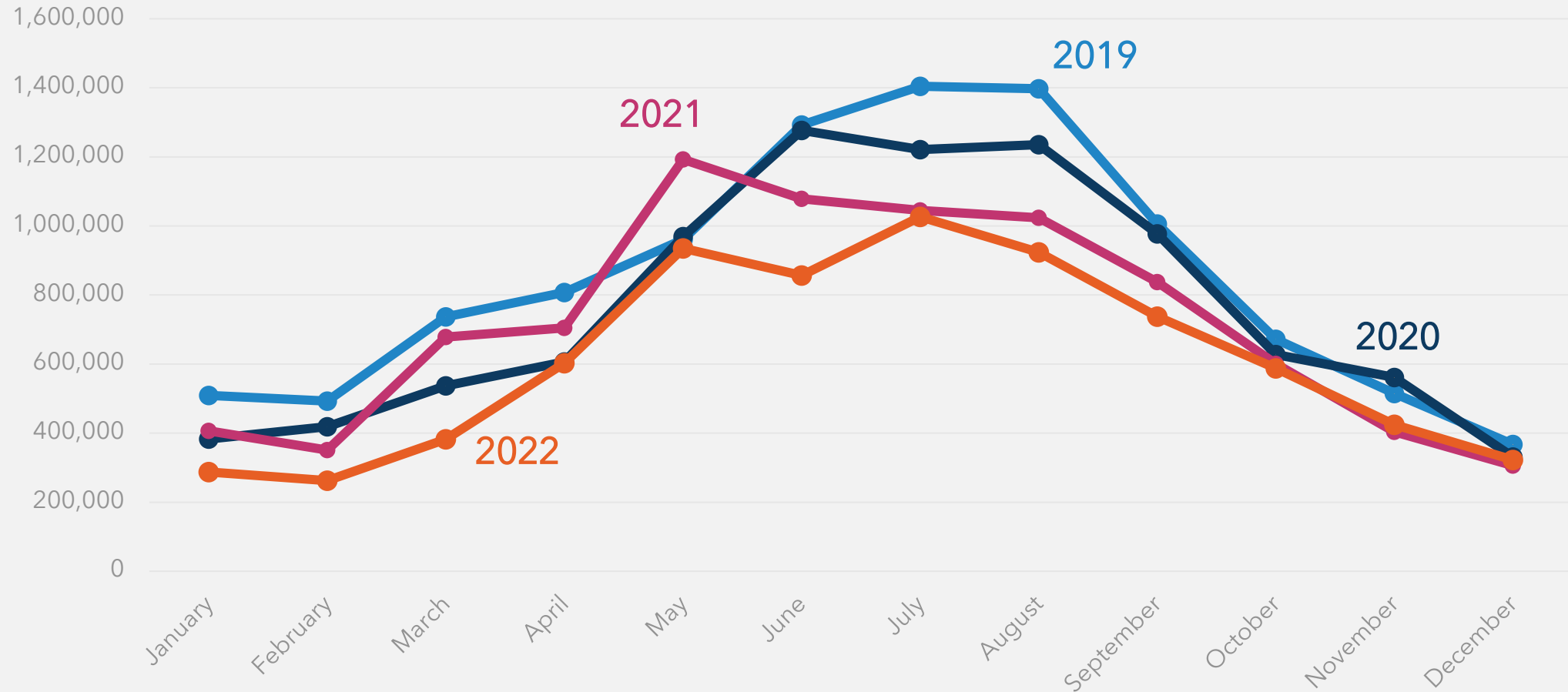

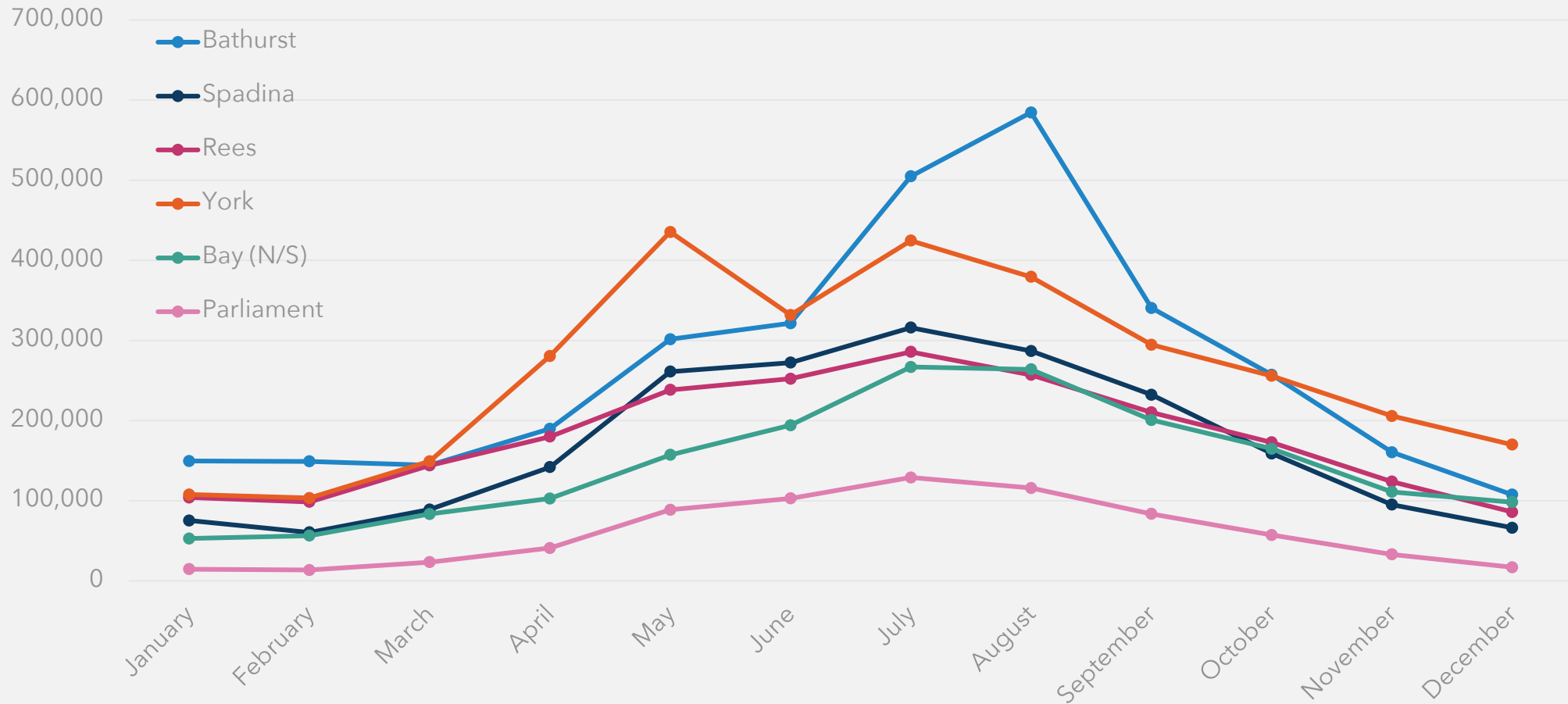

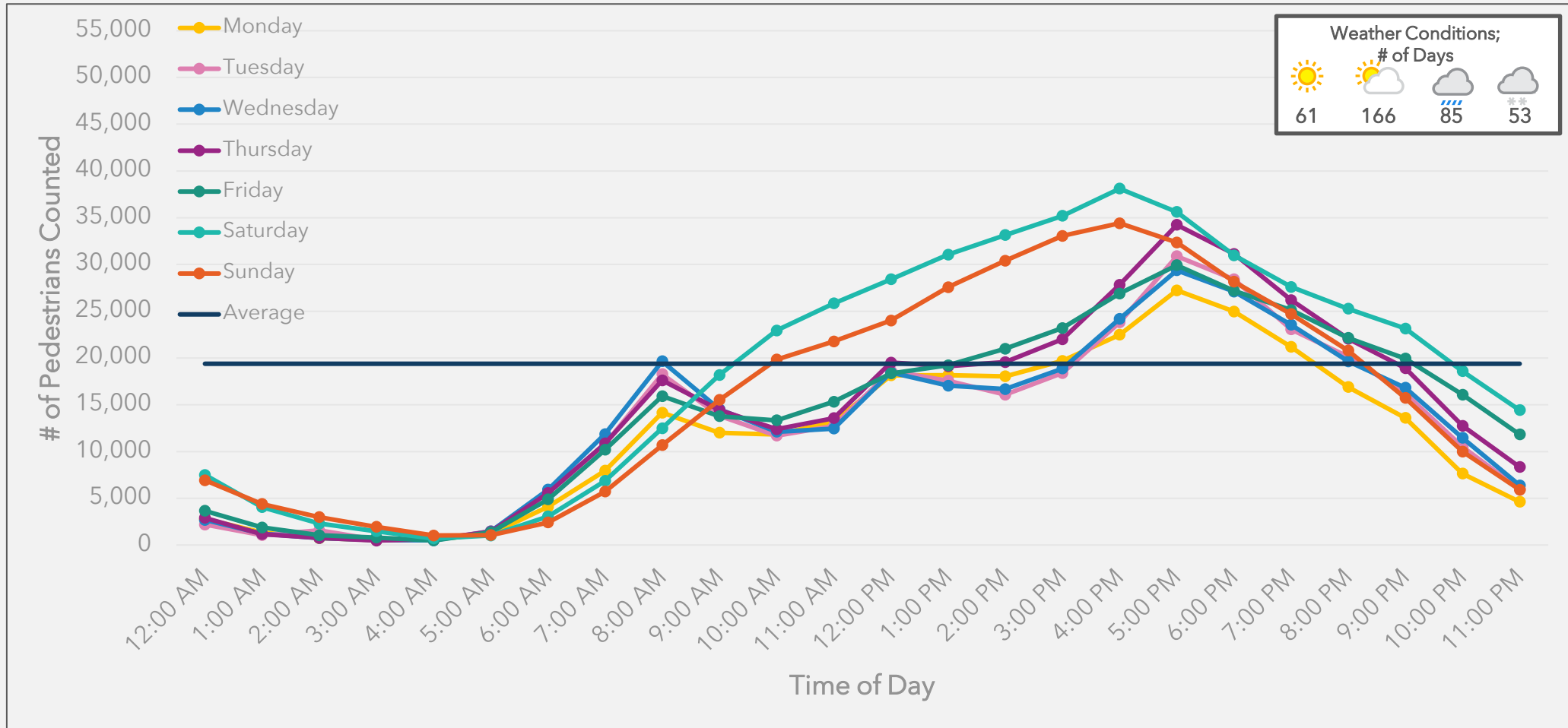


The York Street counter was blocked due to construction during the months of April and May and therefore the numbers for York Street for those months were estimated based on previous years
