



## Streetcar Service Update: Overhead Upgrades - Queens Quay West, west of Spadina Avenue

**October 21 to 25, 2024 - 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., nightly**

### What we are doing and why

Overhead work on Queens Quay West between Spadina Avenue and Bathurst Street is progressing. To safely conduct some of the critical upgrades, overhead electrical power will need to be turned off in the area nightly between **October 21 to 25, 2024**.

During this work the 509 Harbourfront streetcars will be replaced by buses. 509 Harbourfront streetcars will resume daily at the start of service.

### Work activities and locations

Work will be conducted along the 509 Harbourfront streetcar right-of-way on Queens Quay West between Spadina Avenue and Bathurst Street.

### Equipment

TTC overhead trucks with hydraulic equipment will be used to carry out this work. While efforts will be made by the crew to keep noise to a minimum, beeping sounds when the trucks are backing up will be audible. Equipment lights may also be noticeable.

### Work hours

Work is occurring throughout the day, however the work requiring power to be turned off will be conducted when streetcars are not operating between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.

### Motorist, cyclist, and pedestrian impacts

- Work will take place within the streetcar right-of-way, on TTC property.
- Motorists may notice increased traffic along Queens Quay West due to replacement buses.
- Sidewalks and cyclist lanes will be maintained.

### TTC service – October 21 to 25, 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. nightly

- 509 Harbourfront streetcars will be replaced by buses between Union Station and Queens Quay West and Spadina Avenue.
- Regular streetcar service will resume daily at the start of service.
- Wheel-trans service will be maintained.
